Lincolns New Salem State Park, the pioneer village where Lincoln lived as a young adult. Costumed interpreters take on the roles of people who lived and worked here during Lincoln's six-year stay more than 170 years ago. He studied Law, was elected legislator, was postmaster & started a general store.

Old State Capitol served as the Illinois statehouse from 1839 to 1876. The building's perfectly balanced design, majestic classical columns symbolize the ancient Greek example of orderly progress and democracy

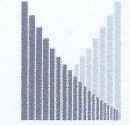


Civil War Flag Retreat Ceremony at Lincoln's tomb, performed by the 114th Infantry Volunteer Regiment
Home of Abraham Lincoln restored to its 1860's appearance, revealing Lincoln as a husband, father, politician, President-Elect and where he lived for 17 years in the only home he ever owned.

Lincoln's Tomb marks the final resting place of Abraham, Mary Todd, Tad, Eddie and Willie Lincoln.
Illinois State Capitol The current structure is the sixth to serve as capitol and took 20 years to build.



Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum presents the life of Abraham Lincoln through a series of stories richly illustrated with personal memorabilia, fascinating documentary material of the Lincoln family, and engaging interactive activities. You will be immersed in the sights and sounds of the past and introduced to the people, places, and events that shaped the life of our 16th president. A reproduction of the White House as it



looked in 1861 plus holographic and special effects theaters will entertain, educate, and mesmerize you with ghostly images, live actors, and high action.

Chanute Aerospace Museum, the largest aviation museum in Illinois, with a collection of over 40 aircraft including military fighters, bombers, rescue, recon, and cargo aircraft. Many of these were used for training purposes at Chanute, and most are on loan from the United States Air Force Museum
